Shadow New Works' technical team and staff over the course of the summer to get hands-on experience planning, producing and managing an outdoor mini dance festival. Duties may include attending advanced meetings with artists, supporting communication between New Works, the Stage Manager, and the venue, preparing technical requirements communications, and more. The successful applicant will work closely with New Works staff to support the realization of all summer All Over The Map performance dates.

Fee: This is an unpaid position.

Availability: You must be available in-person on Granville Island from 8am to 5pm on Sunday, July 20 and Sunday, August 17, 2025.
